ADMINISTRATIVE INFORMATION

1. Type, venue, dates and timing

The 18th NATO CA²X² Forum 2023 is a residential event hosted in **Rome (Italy)** on **3-5 October 2023 at the "Ergife Palace Hotel & Conference Center"**, located in "Largo Lorenzo Mossa n. 8, Roma" (+39 06 66441, www.ergifepalacehotel.com).

2. Registration

Registration should be made through the NATO M&S COE official web site https://www.mscoe.org/event/nato-ca2x2-forum-2023/ from 15 May 2023 through 1 September 2023.

A confirmation message will be sent within 3 working days, including a registration code for each prospective participant, in order to proceed with the conference registration. Each prospective participant registers (through the same web-site platform) with the code provided. The payment of fees shall be made at the last step of the registration process, as prerequisite to complete the participant's enrolment.

3. Lodging and Transportation

Attendees are responsible for the arrangement of their own accommodation and transportation from/to Airport. Taxi and public bus/metro services are available.

The recommended Hotel is the **Ergife Palace Hotel & Conference Center** where the event will take place. The hotel is a 6 minute walk from the nearest BUS stop and a 15 minute walk from the nearest (underground) LINEA "A" METRO stop "Cornelia", Contact the hotel (http://www.ergifepalacehotel.com) to check transportation services availability.

A limited number of rooms have been reserved at a special rate from 2-5 October 2023 at the "Ergife Palace Hotel & Conference Centre" on a first come, first served basis. Please be aware that October is a popular destination for tourists at this time of year and the Forum follows a week after a major sporting event. Participants are strongly encouraged to reserve their hotel room as soon as possible.

4. Conference Fees

The Conference fee, that will help to cover event related costs, is €. 310 for each attendee. The respective fee should be paid by (credit – debit) card in order to complete the registration process (an official receipt will be provided).

5. Social events:

6. Dress Code.

7. Information security

The event is open not only to NATO Nations, NATO Bodies, EAPC, MD, ICI, NATO Partners across the Globe, and UN, EU, OSCE Representatives, but, on a case-by-case basis, and upon approval, participants outside the listed entities could be admitted.

The conference has no classification marking and all contents will be releasable to the public. The conference will be held under the Chatham House Rule.
